







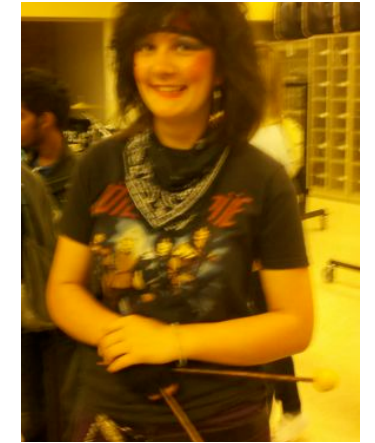

Audition Instructions

Report to UHS 30-45 minutes before your audition time Sign in at the **Check In Table** in the front of the Visual and Performing Arts Building Your room assignment will be given at the check-in table. Warm-up will be in the auditorium. If you are waiting for your audition, do so in the auditorium, not in the halls. Report to your assigned audition room 5 minutes prior to your audition time. The room proctor will tell you when to enter/exit and when to begin playing. Wind audition: chromatic scale, etude, sight reading. Results will be available from your director no later than October 21.

Prop Update

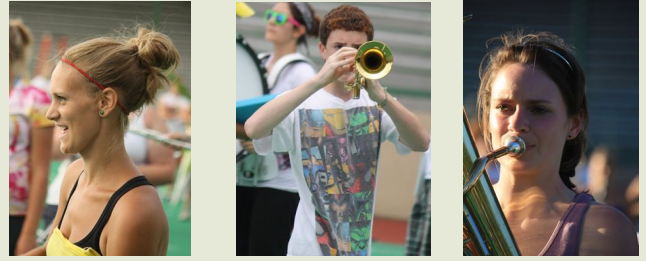
