



Scholarship Guidelines

A policy of the Evergreen Band and Colorguard Boosters ("Boosters") is to encourage and support participation in the Evergreen High School Music and Colorguard programs by all interested students. The objectives of the Boosters include among other things supplying fundraising opportunities to the music and performance ensemble programs and to aid Evergreen High School in projects as they relate to the band and performance ensemble program. As a matter of general policy, the Boosters believe that each interested student should be able to participate in the band and Colorguard programs regardless of the student's ability to pay the fees and costs associated with the program. Accordingly, the Boosters hereby adopts the following guidelines for administration of a scholarship program to assist those students who participate in fundraising opportunities to help offset the cost of participation in the program.

1. Effective July 1st, 2011, fundraising will be handled through a "Points" system.
2. Scholarship considerations and awards are based on total available Participation Points accrued by student, parent, and or student supporter for the student from participation in booster sponsored fundraisers
3. Each Fundraiser event / program will define how Participation Points will be awarded to the student. Fundraisers where monies are collected via sales by students or student supporters will be equated to a Participation Point value per unit sold. Fundraisers where students or student supporters work hours will be equated to a Participation Point value per hour worked.
4. Students will not be awarded a scholarship in an amount greater than the amount of Participation Points they've accumulated through fundraisers.
5. Scholarship requests cannot be for more then what is owed up through the current season.
6. When applying for a scholarship, a form must be completed and signed by the account holder (student and parent/guardian).
7. Scholarship forms are available on the booster web-site.
8. Participation Points accrued through fundraising efforts cannot be sold or redeemed for cash.
9. Participation Points may be requested to be used towards additional students currently in the program.
10. Participation Points may be requested to be transferred to other active students in the program.
